43rd Atlanta Fall Classic

Rules– The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the U.S. Sailing *Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024* including *Appendix B- Windsurfing Competition Rules*, the Class Rules of any applicable fleet, the printed *Notice of Race* and the *Sailing Instructions*. The *Sailing Instructions* will be available at registration/check-in at the Lake Lanier Sailing Club pavilion. Advertising is unrestricted.

Entry– The regatta is open to sailboard competitors. There is no early registration, **however please email the regatta chair if you are coming – voithphoto@gmail.com**. Registration will take place at the race site Friday night and Saturday morning, November 5th & 6th at the LLSC pavilion. Plan for \$45-ish entry fee. Meal deal for non-racers (5 meals) - \$30. Any group of 5 boards may compete in a trophy group including (but not limited to):

Open Unlimited • Sport (7.5 Ltd) • Kona • Windfoil

With enough entries, a **Workshop Fleet** may also be included. Within any of these, divisions (i.e. light-heavy, men-women, etc) with 5 or more entries may also be formed as trophy groups. Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers in up to four divisions. Fleets, Classes and other divisions may be combined, created or deleted at the discretion of the registrar.

Competition Format– Course Racing and/or Long Distance. The courses will be illustrated on the Official Notice board at the LLSC pavilion. The Low Point scoring system will be used. One race must be completed to constitute the regatta.

Wind Minimum– It is intended that after one race is completed, no race will be started in which pumping would be the primary means of propulsion.

Venue– Lake Lanier water temp is 78° as of October 12th. Cold fronts can bring strong wind and cooler air temperatures. Bring neoprene! (this becomes Old Federal Rd.) It's 2.3 miles from McEver Rd. to LLSC entrance on the left. From Charleston: Go to Atlanta, then see above.
